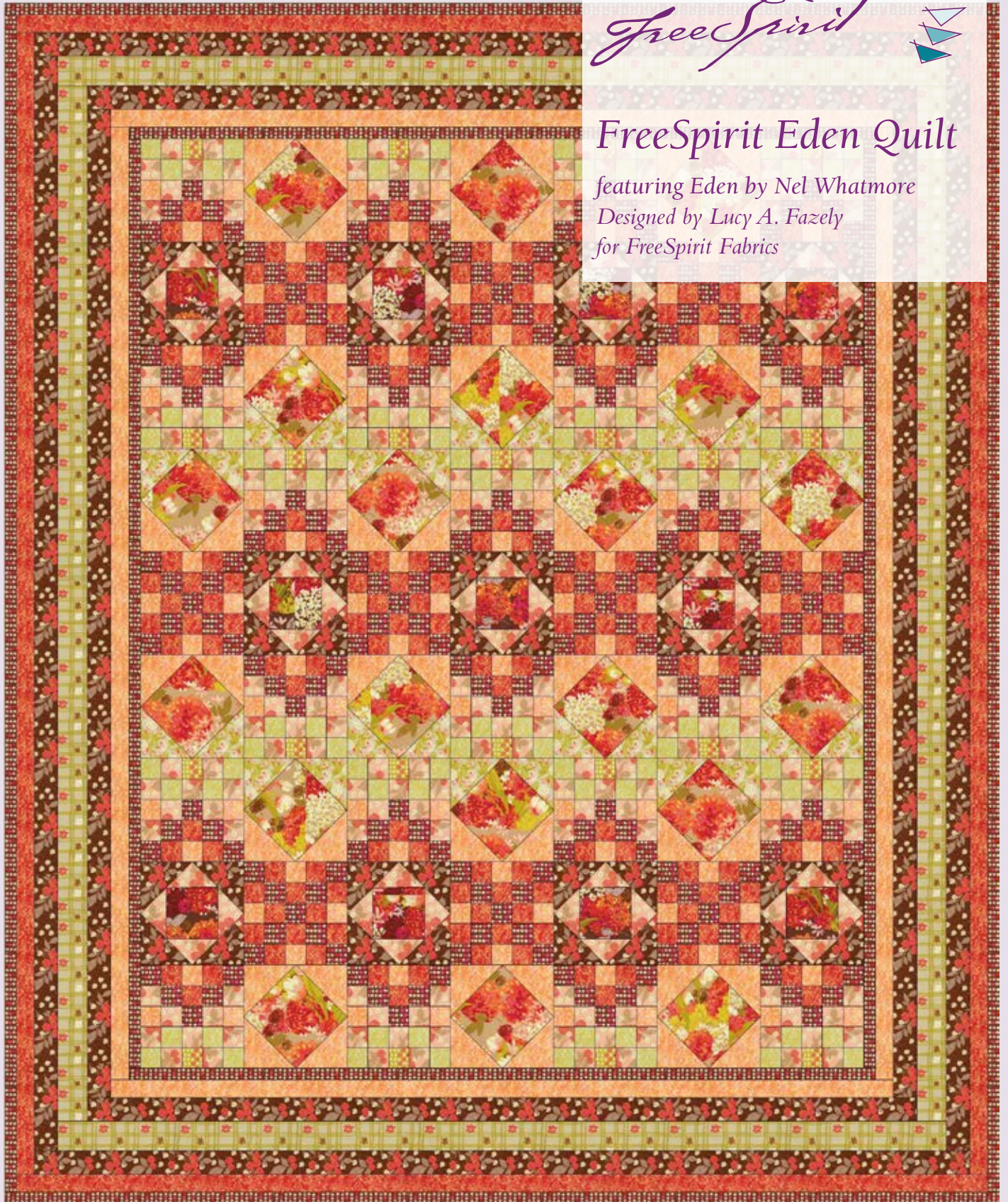

Finished block size: 8-3/4" square (22.23cm x 22.23cm)

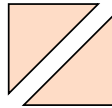

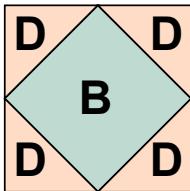

Instructions:

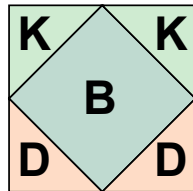
1. Cut each of the 4" (10.16cm) and 5-1/4" (13.34cm) squares in half diagonally once.



2. Stitch a 5-1/4" (13.34cm) half-square triangle to each side of a 6-3/4" (17.15cm) Fabric B square to make the following number of each block.



Make 6



Make 14

3. Sew Fabric G 4" (10.16cm) half-square triangles to the sides of each of the 4-7/8" Fabric A squares. Then stitch a Fabric F 5-1/4" (13.34cm) half-square triangle to each side to make a total of eleven blocks.
